According to NICET, the certification programs "are designed by industry experts and practitioners to ensure a qualified workforce. Certification levels lay out a career path for advancement from entry to senior-level responsibilities."

In addition to passing an exam, a NICET II technician must have a minimum of two years experience in fire detection and signaling systems. This must include at least 12 months of fire alarm systems experience comprised of alarm and detection,

notification, sprinkler monitoring, and interfaces and controls for agent releasing suppression systems. Required functions can include installation, inspection, testing, technical system estimating and sales, plans preparation, and maintenance.
